

BTECH faculty collaborations with students on research projects

- 1. BTECH faculty is encouraged to produce papers with students as co-authors.
- 2. Such papers must follow the Vancouver protocol on authorship.
- 3. Target outlets should always be selected from the BFI lists (series or publisher).
- 4. If a student participates in a conference with the purpose to publish or qualify a paper from a project, BTECH can cover the costs partially or in full. Costs should be modest.
- 5. If a student graduates (becomes an alumni) before the event takes place, item 4 still applies.
- 6. Only conferences in Denmark or Europe will be covered.
- 7. If a student registration fee exists, this category must be selected.
- 8. Travelling and accommodation expenses should be 'cheapest possible'. Food and catering expenses are never covered.
- 9. The department can reimburse costs of up to DKK 10,000 per conference; any exceeding amount is covered by the student(s).
- 10. Conference participation must be approved/supported by a director of studies or a section head and submitted to the department as a standard travel application for final approval.
- 11. As BTECH faculty, you are responsible for correct PURE registration.
- 12. As BTECH faculty, you are responsible for contacting BTECH's communication partner regarding dissemination.
